May is Budget month, and this year the Minister for the Prevention of Family Violence and Sexual Violence, Marama Davidson, has announced that Budget 2022 will include \$114.5 million over four years to support the implementation of Te Aorerekura - the National Strategy to Eliminate Family Violence and Sexual Violence.

While the Wellbeing Budget 2022 has a focus on reforming the health system and addressing climate change, Budget 2022 is also working towards a new approach to public finance. This new approach includes a Justice Cluster - one of two pilots to bring Ministers and agencies together to pursue shared goals. You can read more about Budget 2022 in our News stories.
